

# MASONIC SPOTLIGHT: HIGH BRO, PRINCE PAUL OF ROMANIA

Prior to World War II, Romania had a strong tradition of Freemasonry, but by the end of the war, many northeastern areas of Romania's territories were occupied by the Soviet Union, and Romania forcibly became a socialist republic and a member of the Warsaw Pact. The Soviet Union, like all totalitarian regimes, viewed Freemasonry as a threat to its authority, and Romanian Freemasonry was driven underground for over forty years until the fall of the Iron Curtain in 1989.

As a philanthropist actively involved in numerous charitable organizations, Prince Paul-Philippe Hohenzollern was naturally interested in reviving Freemasonry and the Order of the Eastern Star in Romania. The Prince sought to find a Lodge that could not only make him a Mason, but also provide some guidance in the reestablishment of proper Masonic Ritual in Romania. It is our good fortune that Prince Paul selected The Grand Lodge of Florida and Hillsborough Lodge No. 25. He was Raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason in our Lodge on October 5, 2002.

Prince Paul's wife, HRH Princess Lia, is also involved in charitable activities. Together they promote "The Prince Paul for Romania Foundation" which was established in 1991. To date, the foundation has donated over 6 million Euros (\$7.8 million) to charities and other worthy causes.



As Masons, we can all be proud to call His Royal Highness Prince Paul-Philippe Hohenzollern of Romania our Brother. He has been a member in good standing of Hillsborough Lodge No. 25 for the past ten years, and through his incredibly successful foundation he provides a shining example of Masonic Charity in action.


