


# MASONIC SPOTLICHT: M.: W.: RICHARD G. HOOVER, GM

M∴ W∴ Hoover received the Three Symbolic Degrees of Freemasonry as a member of Nitram Lodge No. 188 in St. Petersburg, Florida, in 1994. He served his Lodge as Worshipful Master in 1998, and as Secretary from 2004 through 2013. He served his District in various committee chairmanships from 1997 through 2008.

He was appointed District Deputy Grand Master for M∴W∴ John R. Givens in 2003, and District Instructor in 2001, 2002, 2005, 2006, and 2013. He was appointed W∴ Grand Standard Bearer in 2007 by M∴ W∴ Robert P. Harry, Jr. He has also served on the Jurisprudence Committee for 5 years, and served on Grand Lodge Committees in the following capacities: Zone Chairman of FA-100 in 2004; Zone Chairman of Public Relations and Publicity in 2008; Zone Chairman of Public Education and Citizenship in 2012; State Chairman of Public Relations and Publicity in 2009; and State Chairman of Masonic Leadership Training in 2010 and 2011. M∴W∴ Hoover was given the Lifetime Appointment of Grand Representative to The Grand Lodge of Arizona for The Grand Lodge of Florida. This esteemed honor was bestowed upon him by M : W : Dale I. Goehrig in 2010.

M∴ W∴ Hoover was elected to the Office of Junior Grand Warden on May 26, 2014, at the 185th Annual Grand Communication; Senior Grand Warden on May 28, 2015; Deputy Grand Master on June 2, 2016. He was elected Grand Master at the 188th Annual Grand Communication and then installed Grand Master of Masons of Florida on his 65th Birthday, May 31, 2017.

M∴ W∴ Hoover was Coronated a 33° Scottish Rite Mason in November of 2013. He served as Master of Kadosh in 2008, and has served on various committees in the Scottish Rite Valley of Tampa. He continues to be an active supporter of the Scottish Rite. He is also a proud member of the St. Petersburg York Rite Bodies and Sunshine Commandery; Selama Grotto; Egypt Temple AAONMS; Bethlehem Chapter No. 169, Order of the Eastern Star; Past President of the Suncoast Master Masons Association; Past President of the Past Masters Unit; Past President of the Past Master Organization; and member of the Royal Order of Scotland, Maxwell Clan.

In his spare time, he enjoys umpiring youth baseball games, something he has been doing for over 35 years. He also contributes time to the Skyway Trap & Skeet as a Board Member in charge of By-Laws and Charter issues. He also enjoys golf, trap and skeet, bowling, and collecting Masonic paraphernalia and memorabilia.
