



My Brothers,

With a quarter of the year behind us, there are issues that need to be addressed. As usual, there are many brothers who have not paid their dues for 2024. Worshipful Billy Schmidt sent out the dues notices and included an information card in each one showing two ways to pay your dues online. Many brothers have used either Square (click here for the Square payment portal) or the Amity App to pay their dues. Many have sent a check to the lodge which have all been deposited and dues cards sent out. I do offer the following apology for some of the checks sitting for several months before being deposited. There was some confusion in the transition of the secretary's office which caused a delay in getting many of the checks deposited. However, there are still many brothers who have not paid their dues for 2024. To avoid getting a summons to show why

your dues have not been paid, please go online, or send in a check to renew your membership in the greatest fraternity on earth.

We are getting many dues notices returned as undeliverable. Did you move and did you notify the lodge of your change of address? If you have not received your 2024 dues notice, please contact the lodge by mail or call the lodge number at **(813) 229-2305** and leave a message on the grasshopper voice mail. I would ask that you speak slowly and any word that might not be clear, that you spell it out. Make sure to leave your phone number on the message. If I can't understand what you are saying, I will call you back and clarify what I can't understand or if something is missing, like your new ZIP code.

There seems to be a renewed interest in Masonry by the younger generation. We see petitioners on a weekly basis coming to the lodge to meet the brothers and to let us get to know them. Do you know someone who would be a good candidate for Masonry, invite them to join us on Tuesday nights for dinner and see the lodge and meet the brothers. We are always willing to talk to perspective candidates for the three symbolic degrees. Dinners start at 6:30 PM and we start a stated communication at 7:15 PM and called communications at 7:30 PM. Come to the lodge and bring a guest.

The more information we have in the office, the better we can serve the craft. That became very evident when we sent out notices last year regarding several changes to the by-laws and the notice to the craft that we had received an offer to sell the building. A great crowd that night with the changes to the by-laws being approved, and the brothers deciding not to entertain the offer to sell the building. Parking is still an issue that we are working on with the city of Tampa and various parking lot owners. We can no longer use the parking lot behind the lodge, so plan to find a parking place on the street and be prepared to pay for that parking until we can get something worked out.

Table lodge will be September 3rd, 2024 at the Shrine. Tickets will be available soon, so plan to attend and by your tickets as soon as they are available. Our Junior Warden is working hard to make this a memorable event, so support him and the lodge by making your plans now to join us on September 3rd.

Last but not least, remember that this is your lodge and that the officers who have been elected to serve are serving for you. Your input into the lodge is vital. Changes have been made to the interior of the building and more are planned. Come down and see what your lodge is doing to keep the building looking great and up to date. Try to schedule on Tuesday night a month to come to the lodge and meet with the officers and other members of this great lodge.

23rd Annual Hillsborough 25 Table Lodge



Tuesday September 3, 2024

6:30 PM — 9:30 PM EDT

Traditionally, upon completion of Masonic labors, a repast was attended and enjoyed by all the Members, as the Lodge was said to be at refreshment. In the early nineteenth century, a much more formal approach to refreshment was adopted by French Freemasons. It was termed a Loge de Table, or Table Lodge. The Table Lodge was opened in the Entered Apprentice degree for the purpose of allowing Brothers who had received the first degree to be present for the occasion. A similar practice was adopted by our Lodge 23 years ago by Worshipful Walter Schoepf, Past Master 2005. Since then, this tradition has continued and the annual Hillsborough No. 25 Table Lodge has become an event that Brothers from around the State look forward to each year.

This event is open to all Entered Apprentices and Fellowcrafts. A valid and current Dues Card, or Avouchment for EA's & FC's, is required by Master Masons in good standing. Aprons are not required. This event is for Masons only. Admission ticket includes the multiple course meal, beverages, commemorative cannon glass, full program. All sales are final, no refunds or equivalent cash value.

In previous Table Lodges, we enjoyed fellowship and great food with over 150 Brothers in attendance. Below is an example of our multiple course meal:

- 2nd Course: Chilled Cucumber Soup
- 3rd Course: Maryland Crab Cake w/ Creole Marmalade
